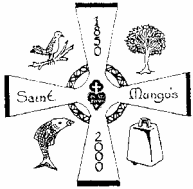

Our Lady of Sorrows Novena

The Solemn Novena in honour of Our Lady of Sorrows continues until Friday, 15 September. The Novena Service, which includes Mass, is at 12.00 noon and 7.00 p.m. on Sunday, and at 12.15 and 7.30 p.m. on weekdays. Petition forms and prayer leaflets are at the church door. **Because of the novena, there will be no 6.00 p.m. Mass from Monday to Friday.**
