Blessed Charles – Healing Holy Hour

On Thursday of this week at 7.30 p.m., there will be an Hour of Prayer for Healing, through the intercession of Blessed Charles of Mount Argus, Passionist Priest, who died in Dublin in 1893. The "Holy Hour" (which usually lasts about an hour and a quarter) includes the celebration of Mass, followed by Blessing with the Relic of Blessed Charles, and concluding with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Tea is available in the Hall after the Holy Hour. This monthly Holy Hour, praying for healing through the intercession of Blessed Charles is part of our preparation for his canonisation which we hope will be celebrated next year.
