Understanding the Catholic Faith

Would you like to know more about the Catholic Faith? Each year we have a course of instructions for people who wish to become Catholics (the R.C.I.A.), but what about those who are already Catholic and would like to know more or to have their memories refreshed? This year (2006/2007) in Saint Mungo's we will be offering an introduction to the Catholic Faith which those who are already Catholic can also attend. Beginning on Wednesday of next week, 29 November, there will be a weekly class for adults based on the Catholic Truth Society's programme *Evangelium*. The sessions will run from 7.30 to 9.30 p.m. (including, of course, a tea break) and will take place in the Bottom Hall. The course book, which covers all twenty-five sessions, costs £7.95 and is available from the Bookshop, or in the Hall during the course. This is a wonderful opportunity to understand the Faith of the Church from an adult point of view. If you're not sure whether you want to take part or not, why not come along to the introductory session on Wednesday, 29 November at 7.30 p.m.
