Because Christmas Eve is a Sunday this year, the First Mass of Christmas (Vigil Mass) will be on Christmas Eve at 7.00 p.m. There will be Mass in French on Christmas Eve at 8.15 p.m. Midnight Mass will begin at 12.00 Midnight, and will be preceded by Christmas Carols at 11.30 p.m. There will be Mass on Christmas Day at 10.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon (especially for children). Masses on Saint Stephen's Day (26 December) will be at 10.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon only. **There will be no evening Mass on Christmas Day, 26 December, New Year's Day and 2 January.**
