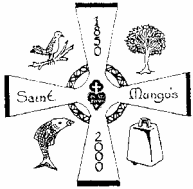

### Our Lady of Sorrows Novena

The Solemn Novena in honour of Our Lady of Sorrows continues until Saturday, 15 September. The Novena Service, which includes Mass, is at 12.00 noon and 7.00 p.m. on Sunday, 12.15 and 7.30 p.m. on weekdays, and 12.15 and 6.00 p.m. on Saturday. Petition forms and prayer leaflets are at the church door. **Because of the novena, there will be no 6.00 p.m. Mass from Monday to Friday this week.**

**Calling all bakers:** There will be a buffet in the Middle Hall at the evening Mass on the last two nights of the Novena: the Feasts of the Holy Cross (Friday, 14 September) and of Our Lady of Sorrows (Saturday, 15 September). If you can bake a cake for either night (or both), please hand it in before the Novena Mass.

**La Chanson D'Eve (The Song of Eve):** On Thursday, 20 September at 7.30 p.m., Louise Macdonald and Graeme McNaught will give a performance of *la Chanson d'Eve* (The Song of Eve) by Gabriel Fauré. It is a rarely performed song cycle, in which voice and piano are interwoven, as Eve names the whole of creation and wonders in its glory. The themes of light and colour are present throughout the music and the Creation Windows of Saint Mungo's, by stained glass artist Lorraine Lamond, provide a fitting back-drop. Graeme McNaught was the winner of the first Scottish International Piano Competition and has performed with major orchestras of Britain and internationally. He combines a performing career with teaching as a member of staff at the RSAMD. Louise Macdonald began her career as a member of Scottish Opera. She won the Young Singers Messiah Competition and performed Handel's Messiah in Glasgow's Royal Concert Hall. She has given many recitals and performances of the great choral works throughout the country and in Paris, where she was recently studying Sacred Art and Liturgical Music at the Catholic University.
