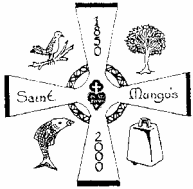

La Chanson D'Eve (The Song of Eve): On Thursday, 20 September at 7.30 p.m., Louise Macdonald and Graeme McNaught will give a performance of *la Chanson d'Eve* (The Song of Eve) by Gabriel Fauré. It is a rarely performed song cycle, in which voice and piano are interwoven, as Eve names the whole of creation and wonders in its glory. The themes of light and colour are present throughout the music and the Creation Windows of Saint Mungo's, by stained glass artist Lorraine Lamond, provide a fitting back-drop. Graeme McNaught was the winner of the first Scottish International Piano Competition and has performed with major orchestras of Britain and internationally. He combines a performing career with teaching as a member of staff at the RSAMD. Louise Macdonald began her career as a member of Scottish Opera. She won the Young Singers Messiah Competition and performed Handel's Messiah in Glasgow's Royal Concert Hall. She has given many recitals and performances of the great choral works throughout the country and in Paris, where she was recently studying Sacred Art and Liturgical Music at the Catholic University.
