### **Message for Lent**

This year, the theme of Pope Benedict's Message for Lent is from Saint Paul's Second Letter to the Corinthians: *Christ made Himself poor for you*" (2 Cor 8:9). Here is an extract from the Pope's Message:

"Jesus made Himself poor to enrich us out of His poverty (cf. 2 Cor 8,9); He gave His entire self for us. Lent also through the practice of almsgiving, inspires us to follow His example. In His school, we can learn to make of our lives a total gift; imitating Him, we are able to make ourselves available, not so much in giving a part of what we possess, but our very selves. Cannot the entire Gospel be summarized perhaps in the one commandment of love?"
