On Friday of this week, 22 February at 7.30 p.m., Peter Kearney from Australia will present *Good Morning, Good People*, a musical version of the life of Saint Francis of Assisi (in the church). On Saturday, 8 March, also at 7.30 p.m., Aleksander Kudajczyk (the Polish concert pianist who was discovered working as a cleaner in Glasgow University) will play Chopin in the Middle Hall. Tickets for both events (£5 each) are available in our bookshop. These events are part of *Lentfest*, a festival of music, drama and art organised by the Archdiocese of Glasgow Arts Project.
