Next Week is Holy Week

Next Sunday, Palm Sunday, is the first day of Holy Week. Palms will be blessed outside the church before the Vigil Mass (6.00 p.m.) on Saturday evening and opposite the Church at 11.50 next Sunday morning.

Caledonian University Retreat: The annual Lent Retreat in Glasgow Caledonian University will take place from Monday to Thursday of this week. This year's retreat will be given by Father Paul Francis C.P. The retreat theme is "Following Christ". The retreat session is from 12.10 to 12.45 every day in the Faith and Belief Centre which is on the ground floor of the Harley Building in the centre of the campus.

Saint Patrick and Saint Joseph: Because of Holy Week, Saint Patrick's Day will be celebrated in Scotland on Friday of this week, 14 March, and Saint Joseph's Day will be celebrated on Saturday, 15 March.

Monthly Youth Mass: St Mungo's Young Adult Group invites other young adults to the Monthly Mass for Young People today (Sunday) at 7.00 p.m. The Mass will be followed by Pizza in the Middle Hall.
