### **Corpus Christi**

Today is the Feast of Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of Christ. We welcome all those who have made their First Communion this year to the 12.00 Mass and Eucharistic Procession. First Communion Certificates will be distributed after the Procession. Weather permitting, this will be followed by a barbecue in the yard.

**Feast of the Sacred Heart:** Friday of this week is the feast of the Sacred Heart. There will be exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from 6.30 until 7.30 p.m., followed by a special Mass at 7.30 p.m. At the Mass we will consecrate our Parish Community to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Please make a special effort to be present at the Mass, at which we will entrust ourselves and those we love to the Love of the Heart of Christ.

**Roses for the Sacred Heart:** Each year on the Feast of the Sacred Heart, the Sacred Heart Altar in Saint Mungo's is decorated with about two hundred red roses. This year the Feast is Friday, 30 May. If you wish to make a donation for roses, please give it to Agnes Glen, Susan Stewart or one of the priests.

**Young Adult Group:** This group will meet on Tuesday evening from 7.30 to 9.00 p.m. in Saint Mungo's Retreat for prayer and reflection, based on the themes of the World Youth Day. New members are welcome.
