### **World Youth Day**

Our group of young pilgrims will leave next Saturday for the World Youth Day in Australia. The group will go first to Melbourne where they will take part in the international Passionist Youth event, joining other young people from Passionist parishes, retreat houses and chaplaincies worldwide. After the Passionist Youth event, they will travel to Sydney to take part in the World Youth Day with Pope Benedict XVI. During their stay in Sydney, the group will be based at the Passionist parish of Saint Brigid, Marrickville, Sydney. They will return to Glasgow on Tuesday, 22 July. We wish them a very fruitful pilgrimage and, on behalf of the group, we thank all those who have supported their fund-raising efforts over the last three years.

As Speaker, Mr Martin will not vote on the Bill, but it would still be helpful for him to receive a letter from you expressing your view.
