Our Lady of Sorrows Novena

The Solemn Novena in honour of Our Lady of Sorrows begins today (Sunday) at the 12.00 noon and 7.00 p.m. Masses and continues until Monday, 15 September. The Novena Service, which includes Mass, is at 12.15 and 7.30 p.m. on weekdays, 12.15 and 6.00 p.m. on Saturday, and 12.00 noon and 7.00 p.m. on Sunday. Petition forms and prayer leaflets are available at the church door. **During the novena, there will be no 6.00 p.m. Mass, except on Saturday.**

Communauté Francophone (Mass for French-speaking Catholics): Mass in French is offered in Saint Mungo's today (Sunday) and on the first Sunday of every month at 3.00 p.m. All are welcome.

R.C.I.A. – Journey of Faith: The new R.C.I.A. session will begin later this year. The R.C.I.A. group exists to help adults who wish to prepare to be baptised or confirmed or who are interested in becoming Catholics. The group normally meets from the autumn until Pentecost. Meetings are held weekly and last about an hour and a half. The meeting includes a time of prayer, scripture reading, a chance to talk and share our faith together, and instruction on some aspect of the Catholic faith.
