### **Holy Week – Special Moments**

Today is Passion Sunday or more commonly called Palm Sunday. It is a time for great rejoicing in, reflecting on, and celebrating the Word of God.

We are reminded of the entry of Jesus into Jerusalem with great happiness among the people at the coming of the one whom they believed to be the Saviour. The Messiah who would free them from their burdens and fill their hearts with a great awareness of God's saving love. That was then, but what about now?
