'Doubt no longer'

Today as we gather together on this Third Sunday of Eastertide, we hear Jesus invite his disciples to doubt no longer, but believe. This is something that we all can do, but like the disciples we are sometimes afraid to believe. After all, to believe would mean accepting that what Jesus asks of us we should do.

Are you ready to let go of selfishness, impatience, anger, resentment, or any other problems we have to allow the Lord to take control of our hearts? Are there people that really annoy you so much that you cannot find something good to say about them? If problems like these persist in your life, perhaps it is an indication that we still have to let the Lord take complete control of our hearts. Perhaps like the disciples in the gospel today, we find it hard to recognise the Lord in the people of our neighbourhood, our workplace or school? Perhaps, like the disciples, we have to accept the invitation of the Lord to let go of our fears and 'doubt no longer'.
