**The Second Collection today is for the work of Communications**

### **'Live in God, by loving his people'**

If we live in love we are recognised as people of God. St John reminds us of this in the second reading today. But St John also reminds us that we must put our trust in God, he calls this faith.

This faith helps us to experience the love of God in our hearts and to grow in greater awareness of the love that God wants us to share with his people. This is not always easy to do. People sometimes are not prepared to accept God's love. They often forget that Jesus loved us so much that he even died for us. That is why when we pray we ask that God will send his Spirit into our lives. The Spirit helps us to be able to love even those who are not always nice. He helps us to reach out to those who are not willing to trust in God.

Why not try this week to show God's love to someone who do not always follow God's ways. Love one another as I have loved you says the Lord.
