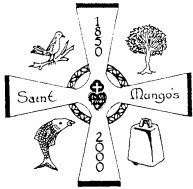

'Beginning Lent'

This Wednesday sees us begin the season of Lent. Traditionally Ash Wednesday is a time for making promises of what we will do during Lent to bring us closer to God. It may be striving to be a more gentle person, or having more patience, or denying ourselves some of the little treats we usually have in order to help those who have nothing? We may decide to try and attend Mass during the week or spend a little time praying as a family? But whatever we decide, let us all make sure that we decide to understand what God is asking us to do as we walk in the footsteps of Jesus.

To begin this season of Lent, we will have the following Masses this Wednesday:

8.15am, 10.00am, 12.15pm, 6.00pm and 7.30pm in the Church. We will also have two Masses **at 12.10pm and 1.10pm in Room M201 of Caledonian University.** Due to 'in service' days, there will be NO Masses in St Stephen's or St Kevin's Primary Schools.

On the **Fridays** of Lent, we will have **Stations of the Cross after the 10am Mass and again at 7.00pm in the evening.** Also, we will have the opportunity to reflect on the **Sacraments** through scripture and how we practice these sacraments today (Details next week).

Bereavement Group will meet on Tuesday (16th)e Retreat from 7.30pm until 9.00pm.
